

2024 EAGLE RACEWAY TRAILER RACE RULES

Trailer Race will be on Saturday, June 15th after the races at Eagle Raceway,
617 S. 238th St, Eagle, NE.

OBJECT OF THE RACE: This is not a race! The purpose is fun & destruction not to just race with no hitting! The Object of the event is to knock your competitors trailer off his/her vehicle. The last vehicle still moving on the track with trailer properly attached will be the winner!

PURSE/AWARDS: Winner of race will win \$1000 & Award 2nd \$800 & Award 3rd \$500 & Award. Participants should pre-register by June 10th. If pre-registered by June 10th, The driver will get 2 free pit passes. \$500 & Award for the MAD DOG. The MAD DOG AWARD will be determined by the officials picking the top 3 hitters. Then the crowd will vote on the Mad Dog winner out of the selected 3.

1. Tow Vehicle may be any car, pick-up, station wagon, or suburban. No buses, motor homes, or farm trucks. This event is meant to be fun for all involved. Please do not compromise this aspect by over-building your entry. All entries will be inspected for safety. If deemed unsafe you will not be allowed to compete unless it is fixed and re inspected.
2. Participant and passengers must have Fire Suit, gloves, helmet, and neck brace. Helmets must have full-face shield. Window nets are mandatory for driver and passenger. A race receiver is required for the driver for safety and communication from race director. You may borrow one from a racecar driver or buy one from Speedway Motors.
3. Racing seat belts (minimum 4 point) required for driver and passenger. The belts must be attached to the cage preferably a cross bar between your down posts of your cage. No OEM belts will be allowed.
4. All glass must be removed from tow vehicle and trailers. All mirrors, side trim, taillights, and headlights must be removed from tow vehicle and trailers. Battery must be securely fastened.
5. Trailers must be an actual trailer that has been used in that capacity! No spreader type trailers, no chunk of iron with axle attached, trailer must be at least 5 ft. wide. All trailers need at least 5/16 safety chains attached from trailer to towing vehicle. Must be bolted or welded. Trailers must be at least 6 feet long (hitch to end of trailer). Trailers will be inspected for safety. If deemed unsafe you will not be allowed to compete unless it is fixed and re inspected. If hitch breaks and track officials deem trailer unsafe you will be black flagged and removed from the track.
6. ROLL CAGE rear hoop behind driver and passenger is required with 2 kick down bars from top of hoop. Must be a minimum of 1 ½" in diameter; .095 thickness; and no exhaust pipes for tubing. Preferred would be a 4 point cage with two door bars on each side. The driver must set below the hoop of the cage. You can have external protection on the outside of your doors. Tubing or plate no farther forward then the end of the doors, not on the front fenders.
7. No radios or communication devices are allowed besides Race Receiver. Race Receiver is mandatory (Most Eagle Raceway drivers own one and would likely lend one to you to use if you do not own one.
